- As part of the ongoing 'National Sanitation Campaign', weekly on-campus 'Cleanliness Drives' were organized at ICAR-Central Institute for Women in Agriculture (ICAR-CIWA), Bhubaneswar, during 3rd, 17th and 31st October, 2015.

As instructed by the Council, the "Intensive Swachhta Abhiyan" was also observed during 25th September-31st October, 2015, coinciding with the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhai Patel. As part of it, the following programmes were organized in adopted villages;

Programmes in Adopted Villages:

- ❖ As part of the Collaborative Project on 'Livelihood and Nutritional Improvement of Tribal Farmwomen through Horticulture', an awareness campaign on hygiene and sanitation was organized at Tribal Village Kamaninga in Dhenkanal district in Odisha on 6th October, 2015. The farming communities were sensitized about the hygiene and sanitation, and the significance of keeping the environment neat and clean. The farm families also participated in cleanliness drive, and cleaned the village roads.



- ❖ As part of the TSP Project, an off-campus awareness cum cleanliness drive was conducted at Village Tarajodi in Mayurbhanj District on 15th October, 2015. Farm women, men and rural youth numbering about 80 participated in the programme, and cleaned the approach roads and habitat areas in the village. Awareness was created among them about the *Swachh Bharat* initiatives, and the significance of keeping the village neat and clean, and about the prompt disposal of wastes.



Programmes in AICRP Centres:

- ❖ Under AICRP on Home Science, 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' was conducted on 16th October 2015 in Sonari goan, Jorhat in Assam. The programme was conducted in a school of the adopted village. The school teachers and students actively participated in this sanitation drive.
